

WHAT to report [TITLE II: SSDI, CDB or DWB]



START work.
CHANGE in hours.
CHANGE in pay rate.
CHANGE in marital status if CDB or DWB.
MORE income EARNED in a month.



STOP work.
REDUCE hours.
REDUCE pay rate.
CHANGE in marital status if CDB or DWB.
LESS income EARNED in a month.

Reporting should occur whenever there is a change that requires a decision by SSA:

- Finishing your Trial Work Period.
- SGA work causing benefit cessation.
- Earnings reinstating payments in EPE.

WHAT to report [SSI]



START work.
CHANGE in hours.
CHANGE in pay rate.
MORE income PAID in a month.



STOP work.
REDUCE hours.
REDUCE pay rate.
LESS income PAID in a month.

All changes in income need to be reported – not just changes in **earned** income.

- Unearned income.
- Resources.
- Assistance with food & shelter.
- Change of address.
- Change in marital status.
- Change in living arrangements.
- Use of work incentives.
